

St. George, St. Edward and St. Paul Parish
Confirmation of Parishioner Status for the 2010-11 School Year

The Parish communities of St. George, St. Edward, St. Paul believe in and support the ministry of our Catholic schools. A significant portion of our ordinary parish income is given to the schools each year. These subsidies enable the schools to keep tuition affordable for our parishioners.

We ask those who benefit from the parish subsidy to be active, fully participating members of our parish cluster or parishes in the Rainbow system (Church of the Vietnamese Martyrs, Immaculate Conception, Our Lady of Mt. Virgin, St. James Cathedral, St. Joseph, St. Mary, St. Peter, St. Patrick, and St. Therese Parishes).

“Active, fully participating members” of St. Edward, St. George and St. Paul Parishes are defined as:

- being formally registered in the parish;
- regularly attending Mass and parish events;
- making an annual Parish Stewardship pledge and fulfilling it*; and
- participating in the Annual Catholic Appeal**.

***Parish Stewardship**

The annual Parish Stewardship Renewal takes place in the **fall** of each year at Mass and indicates a giving commitment *to the parish* for the *following calendar* year.

To receive in-parish tuition for the entire 2010-11 school year, families must have a **2010 Parish Stewardship Pledge card on file in the parish office by May 1, 2010, and a 2011 Parish Stewardship Pledge card on file by Dec. 1, 2010.**

****Annual Catholic Appeal**

The Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) takes place in the **spring** of each year at Mass and indicates a giving commitment *to support Archdiocesan ministries*, including the Catholic Schools Department, Office of Faith Formation and Catholic Youth Organization.

To receive in-parish tuition for the entire 2010-11 school year, families must make a **2010 Annual Catholic Appeal pledge by May 1, 2010.**

Families requesting “In-parish” Tuition must fill out this form and submit it to the parish office by May 1, 2010. Parish staff will confirm your parishioner status and return this form to the school. If you have question about your parishioner status, please make an appointment to meet with parish staff prior to submitting this form.
